June 2013 SRC Bulletin Summary

President, Bob Orth, has returned from a long and satisfying vacation. Welcome back.

Treasurer, Bill Spalding, completed transfer of our bank accounts from B of A to Inland Northwest Bank. We look forward to a more friendly and cost effective relationship.

Executive Officer. Larry Bassett, reported one of the 2 attorneys who volunteered to propose a replacement "hold harmless" waiver finally forwarded one to him, but too late to review and provide feedback at this month's board meeting, so it was presented at this meeting. He expects to review it at a future board meeting and make a recommendation to the SRC board.

Progress on membership renewal: As of 6-9-13 we have 1324 members including 151 life, 33 junior, and 214 new members. 74% of 1443 2012 members have renewed.

NOTE: Please take especially good care of your new membership cards because it shows your now **permanent member number**. In the future we will no longer be assigning new numbers and mailing new cards each year. This is to save on the huge number of volunteer hours spent each year by the Treasurer and Secretary. **Thanks!**

Central Air Conditioning for the north range clubhouse was approved by the board and has been installed and works well. We're sure members will appreciate being able to come inside to cool off for a while on hot summer days.

Testing of 10 yard targets on the outdoor pistol range, per the RSO's reports, is not a perfect solution to fascia damage problems but is much better than 7 yard targets. The board approved the next step in testing: installing post holders at ten yards to eliminate the cumbersome temporary target stands. They will have different size and upright post spacing than the other distances, so they will not interchange. If there continues to be too much damage to the fascias on the 25 yard range, even the 10 yard frames must go. The club spent almost \$10,000 last year to replace the fascias – not a good use of range development funds.

Executive Officer, Larry Bassett, reported a new shed was delivered for indoor range storage. A 60" door for the ATV shed was also delivered. Lowell Peterson will install the new 60" door.

Thanks Lowell for this, fixing the target turner frames on the indoor range, arranging the AC installation in the north range clubhouse, and much other volunteer work you have performed for SRC.

There will be an Action Pistol work party at the indoor range on June 29th in preparation for a July 18th match. All help is welcome.

Cast Bullet Chairman, Mike Cooper, Sr., reported 7 competitors at the May 18th cast bullet match, all over 78 years old. Top score was a 0.61" group, with 1 dropped point.

Muzzleloader Chairman, Lee Kershner, reported a good turnout of 25 shooters at the Sunday May 19th Spokane Falls MuzzleLoader's Club match. Their secretary, Dan Carroll, shot a 50 – 3X score off sticks and Dan will be shooting in the Idaho regional match in Boise this month.

BPCR Chairman, Jim Jones, reported the combined BPCR and F-class Match for May was shot in the rain under EZ-up covers, which worked well and kept competitors dry on the shooting line. Those working the pits got quite wet.

Pat Brownier announced the 2 day Bill Havercroft Match, an outdoor 320 Shot smallbore match, scheduled for September 21st and 22nd. It will require iron sights for juniors and any sight for seniors. We will make a perpetual trophy for this annual match which will be displayed in the north range clubhouse.

Pistol Chairman, Jon Coleman, asked for 2 dates to hold outdoor pistol matches in July and August. Likely dates are 21st July and 18th August. See the outdoor calendar.
