



# SPOKANE RIFLE CLUB OPERATIONAL RULES

Revised & Approved February 2018

- Dues must be paid by March 1st or the member will be denied use any range
- Life memberships approved for Executive Committee members who serve two consecutive terms
- SRC Board minutes will not be posted nor made public
- SRC Board will keep SRC finances available at Board Meetings only
- The Junior Division Chairman or his designee will have access to junior division equipment storage at the indoor range
- Junior Division Chairman or an NRA Certified Coach designated by the Junior Chairman must oversee Junior Division events/matches
- Junior Division members may use SRC facilities for practice sessions at no charge and the fee for matches is \$4 per SJRC member
- Members of the SJRC Team may shoot on club property unescorted
- Shotgun Division Chairman or designee may oversee unscheduled trap sessions
- SRC President will handle all media inquires  
In the event of trespass from the river (take out site) RSOs will call the Park Ranger
- The take out site along the Spokane River on SRC property is limited to use by Spokane Fire Department Rescue Team (after coordinating use with the Executive Officer)
- SRC will continue affiliation with the National Rifle Association (#C0900) and remains solely associated with Inland Northwest Wildlife Council for all hunter education courses
- Equipment owned by SRC may only be used by SRC employees
- Lead collected from the Indoor Range will be handled at the discretion of the Indoor Range Division Chairman
