



SPOKANE RIFLE CLUB STANDING RULES

Revised & Approved September 2019

- Any decision made by any Range Safety Officer shall be final and binding on all members and non-members
- Public fishing is allowed on the portion the of the river that is SRC property after checking in at the North Range and signing a waiver
- Lifetime memberships may not be sold or given to others
- A member can bring the same guest only one time per membership per year at no charge
- All shooting (whether pistol or rifle) is limited to one round per second
- 50 BMG ammunition and all ammunition based on the 50 BMG cartridge are prohibited
- Rimfire firearms are not prohibited on 200 yard range
- No person under 14 years of age may shoot any handgun on SRC property
- Open carry of a handgun on club property is limited to sworn officers required by duty
- Shooting is not permitted at the North Ranges, Shotgun Range, or Indoor Range unless an RSO is present
- The 200 yard range closed to non-members except during competitions
- Use of the 300 yard and 600 yard lines is reserved for organized shoots only
- A shooter is permitted to keep his/her brass or give it to another shooter
- \$200 per division per project allowed without needing prior board approval
- Alcoholic beverage consumption is not permitted before or during shooting and recreational drug use is not permitted on club property
- Speed limit on club property is 10mph
- Schedule listed on the website is the master schedule
- Employees of SRC shall not be involved in the sale of any member's personal property (including firearms, lead, spent brass, etc)
- If controlled by owner **AND** on a leash, members' dogs are allowed outdoors on club property
